Directions and Transportation

From Downtown Dallas: Take I-30 East to Rockwall and exit Horizon Rd. Turn right on Horizon Rd. and right on Summer Lee Dr. Follow Summer Lee Dr. to the lakefront and the entrance to the hotel. 20 miles, 26 minutes.

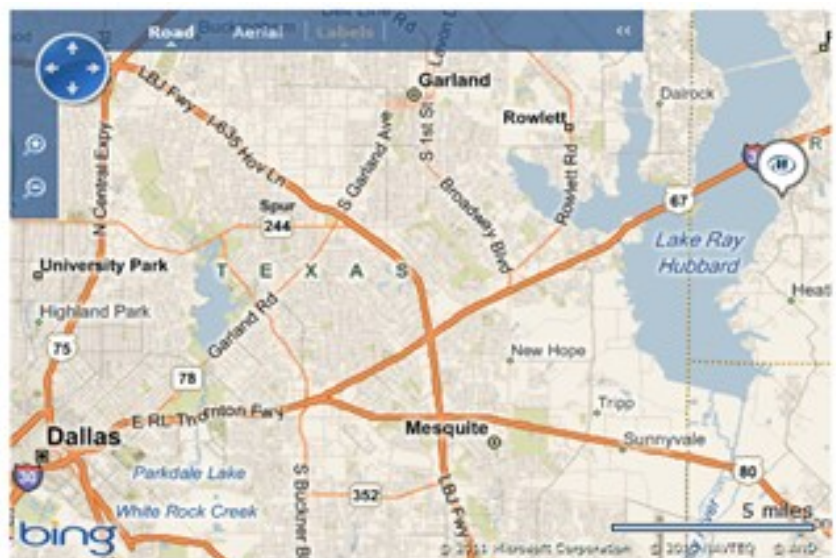
From DFW Airport: Exit the north entrance of the airport to I-635. Follow I-635 approximately 24 miles to I-30 East (Exit 8B). Take I-30 East to Rockwall and exit Horizon Rd (Exit 67A). Keep right at the fork to go on Shoreline trail then right on Summer Lee Drive. Follow Summer Lee Dr. to the lakefront and the entrance to the hotel. 43 miles, 53 minutes.

From Love Field: Exit left out of the airport and follow Mockingbird Ln. to Central Expressway (Hwy 75). Head North on Central to I-635 and go East/South to I-30 East (Exit 8B). Take I-30 East to Rockwall and exit Horizon Rd (Exit 67A). Keep right at the fork to go on Shoreline trail then right on Summer Lee Drive. Follow Summer Lee Dr. to the lakefront and the entrance to the hotel. 29 miles, 44 minutes.

Transportation from DFW or Love Field:

Super Shuttle: \$67 for first passenger and \$10 for each additional, up to 10 passengers, each way. If attendees can arrive and travel to the hotel in groups, there is a significant cost savings.

Taxi: approximately \$75 each way.

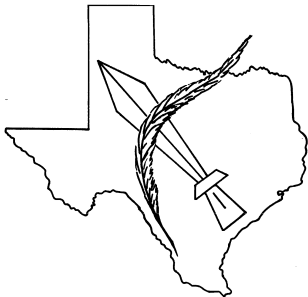
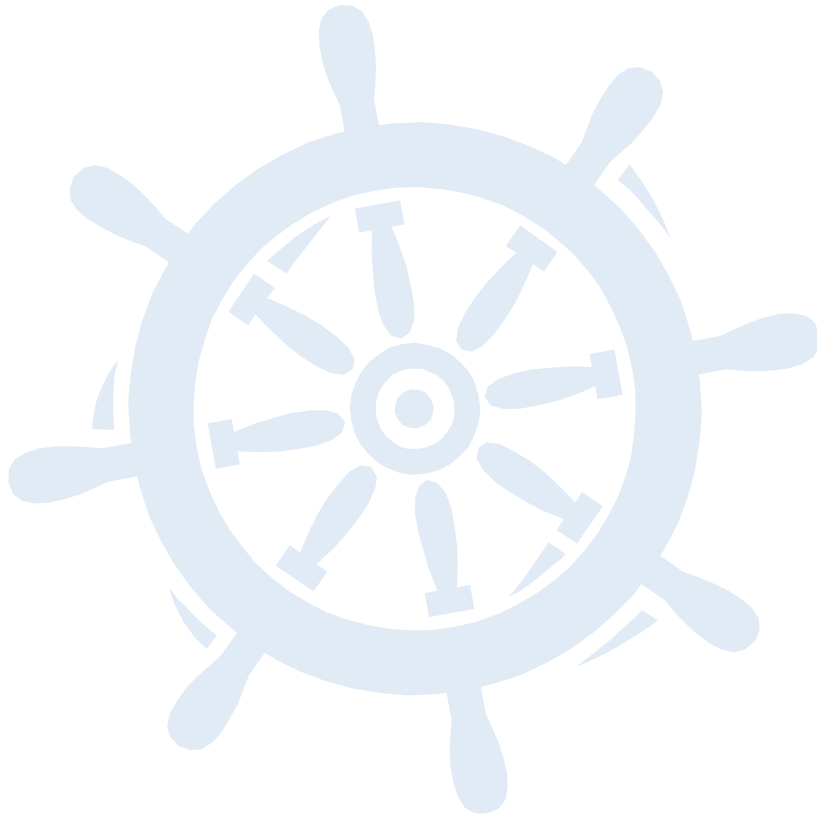
